

## FROM THE INTERNATIONAL PRESIDENT'S DESK.

Calvary greetings to all my GB sisters around the world. These are strange times that we live in and not one of us saw this coming. !! But God knew this would happen.

By this time, I would have been writing this update after our annual IPC meeting for 2020. But as with everything else this year, we cancelled our planned face to face meeting which was to be hosted by GB Europe in May, 2020. What has been happening in GB around the world in this pandemic ?

All our member countries have been on lockdown since late March and GB face to face has been suspended. We praise God that our leaders around the world stepped up and created new ways of staying connected with the girls. This pandemic sent us all into creative mode !! Some countries produced resources for online activities for the different age groups every week. Thank you to all our leaders who were generous enough to share the resources they produced with the GB worldwide families. Granted, not all of us are talented and have access to facilities to enable us to be creative, so we really appreciate the family spirit. As GBI we also produced a 2 part GB Connected Resource to help parents and leaders across the world to support children and young people. We hope you have been able to tape into some of these resources that are readily available on our GB worldwide FB page.

We are happy to learn that some countries have lifted some restrictions and other groups have started face to face meetings, with restriction guidelines to keep us safe. I urge all those who are going into this phase, to please do so with extreme caution to keep us and our girls safe. It cannot be business as usual when we reopen, as this pandemic is not over yet. Let continue to follow guidelines given by our Governments and health authorities.

As IPC, we felt there was a need to go back to the drawing board in terms of our plans for 2020/21 and beyond. The resources that were launched at the beginning of the year, and all the activities planned for 2020 could not be implemented because most if not all were tailor made to face to face interaction. We have held weekly Zoom Meetings since April. Below are some of the outcomes of our Meetings:-

- GB Delegation of Hope to the UN, New York:- All wheels were in motion for the group to travel to New York to arrive on 5<sup>th</sup> March, 2020. GB was going to represented by :

  - GB was going to run a Parrallel event during the Conference and the girls had each prepared a 5 minute presentation on different topics.
  - Due to the outbreak of COVID 19, IPC had an emergency Zoom meeting on 2<sup>nd</sup> March, 2020 and we agreed to cancel our travel plans to New York. It was very disappointing for the team, but we became sure we had made the right decision when New York became the epicenter of the virus a few days after were due to travel. !! We thank God for the insight. Two of our team members were already in New York when we cancelled, Quindell and Cindy. We thank God that He protected them and they safely returned home in good health after a week in New York.
  - We are not sure of the situation in 2021 with regards to the Conference on the Status of Women(CSW).

## **GBI COVID 19 RESPONSE:**

- Having realised that the world was in lockdown because of the pandemic we held a survey to find out the status of our GB groups around the world and assess the needs around the fellowships/countries. We also sort ideas for activities that could be done virtually and help leaders stay connected to the girls. This resulted in the production of the GB Stay Connected Resource.
- We also acknowledge that many of our members are struggling as some have lost their jobs, reduced hours at work. IPC agreed to lessen the burden on our members and reduce the 2020 membership fees due by 50 percent. This is not much, but we pray that this will help our National Boards.

- IPC is also looking at doing Webinars to empower our leaders to be able to be effective in times like these. We carried out a survey of needs from you and from the feedback, we came up with topics for Training Webinars as outlined below :-
